2.1 Primary logo

This is the primary SSAA logo. It is comprised of the folding icon and the Self Storage Association of Australasia wordmark.



This is the SSAA tagline. It is used to support the SSAA primary logo. It sits independently of the logo and is used as either a headline or sign off to appropriate collateral.

Independent spirit. Collective knowledge.

This is the primary SSAA logo. It is comprised of the folding icon and the Self Storage Association of Australasia wordmark.

Each version of the SSAA logo can be applied as follows:

- Navy with light blue highlights on white
- White with light blue highlights on SSAA navy.
- White with navy highlights on SSAA light blue.
- Black on white when four colour printing is not available.

The logo should never be applied on any other colour or over the top of imagery.

All SSAA logos are available as:

PNG files Available in RGB colours only and predominantly used in documents made to be viewed on screen.

Al files: Available in CMYK and PMS colours and predominantly used in print applications.

SVG files Available in RGB colours only and predominantly used on digital assets.

JPEG files Available in RGB colours only and predominantly used on digital assets.





2.4 Clear space

The clear space that must surround the logo is based on 'X' which is determined by the width of the curve in the SSAA folding icon as shown.



To ensure the logo is always visible, it must not be reproduced less than the minimum sizes described. The minimum size for print is 25mm wide, measured from the outer edges of the SSAA wordmark and icon.

The minimum size for digital applications is 30px high, measured from the top and bottom edges of the SSAA icon. In some cases the SSAA icon can be used independently from the logo, however permission must be obtained from the SSAA marketing department.
